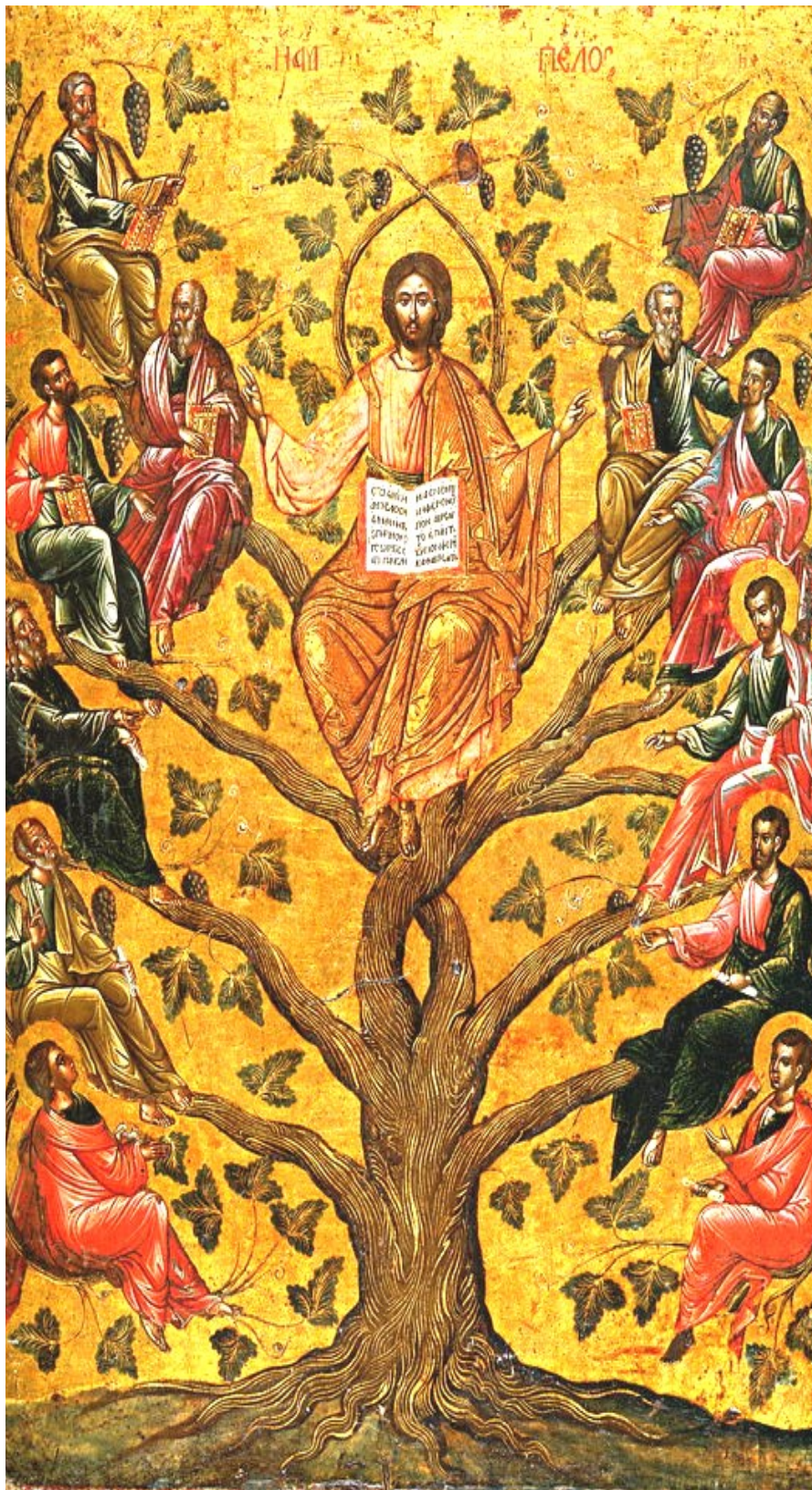

Dear Friends,

We've been finishing walking through some wisdom from *Introduction to the Devout Life* by St. Francis De Sales. He pointed out not only the need for a deep union with God amidst the rhythms of everyday life, but also the reality that as life in Jesus grows, we should become more fully alive, more human. Last week we pondered the importance of healthy recreation and the necessity for spiritual friendship. At one point, reflecting on the reality he wrote, "It is a defect to be so strict, ill-bred, uncouth, and austere as neither to take any recreation ourselves nor to allow it to others."

We are in the midst of the Easter Season, Jesus is Lord, He's alive, He's risen! How are you celebrating? Are you able to rest, find life in the victory Jesus has won? One of the ways we celebrate is to take time and enjoy the gift of recreation. Are you able to enjoy the bike ride, the afternoon at the golf course, hiking, throwing the football, playing guitar, etc.? It seems we can tend to find it easier to observe penance and fasting during the 40 days, and more challenging to know how to celebrate. Perhaps one question, given the pace of life which many of us live, do we recreate at all? How do we go about eating, are we able to have a meal once a week where we just take it slow, make a feast, and enjoy the gift of conversation? When we step into rest and recreation, in Jesus, it is a way to step more deeply into the freedom that is ours as sons and daughters of our Heavenly Father.
